CALL FOR FESTIVAL VENUE TECHNICIAN

Intrepid Theatre Company is seeking an energetic, enthusiastic Venue Technician to run the Intrepid Studio for the OUTstages Festival 2025. The Venue Technician will work in a fast-paced (and fun!) Festival environment to set up, tech, and operate nine performances of seven unique shows by different theatre companies over a two-week period. It's a great way for those with an existing all-round technical theatre skill set to broaden their experience.

General Duties and Responsibilities

Reporting to the Intrepid Production Manager and Assistant Technical Director, the Intrepid Studio Venue Technician will:

- Be responsible for safe and timely set up and strike/restore of the Intrepid Studio
- Facilitate technical show technical set up and rehearsals, and provide support to artists, while
 - o keeping day on schedule, including proactively maintaining scheduled breaks
 - o maintaining proper paperwork on all shows in sufficient detail that another person would be able to operate the show in an emergency situation
- Operate all shows in the Studios including lighting, sound, and video as needed
- Proactively identify and remedy either directly, or by involving the Production Manager, any safety issues affecting staff, artists, patrons, or general public
- Be able to comfortably and safely work at height on ladders
- Assist the Assistant Technical Director with shows at other venues when the Studio schedule allows
- Carry out other related Festival duties as assigned at the Studio or Metro theatres

Technical Proficiencies Required

Lighting – Operate the stage lighting system during tech and shows; install intelligent lighting fixtures, e.g. LED's or moving lights, including addressing them and integrating functionally into console. The Studio is equipped with a manual NSI MC7524 two-scene preset console.

Audio – Operate the PA system, with an analog mixing console, and a Mac mini using QLab for cue playback; set up mics, integrate playback devices, etc., as needed. QLab experience is preferred but not required; the Venue Technician will need to learn basic QLab use.

Video – Operate a simple video projection system, consisting of a basic data projector, VGA or HDMI input, and playback device such as an artist's laptop, using QLab, VLC, or similar video playback software

Remuneration and Terms of Employment

The rate of pay is \$22.58/hr plus 4% Vacation Pay. Overtime is paid according to the Employment Standards Act and the Collective Agreement.

Technical Stage Employees of Intrepid Theatre are represented by IATSE Local 168. The successful Venue Technician candidate must be a member or permittee, or willing to become a permittee of Local 168. Hiring preference will be given to qualified existing Local 168 members.

Time Commitment

The Intrepid Studio Venue Technician will need to be available to work from Tuesday, January 28 to Sunday, February 9, 2025. Set up and tech/show days are typically full days, and show call days are 4 hours depending on show length. The work schedule is approximately:
