Description of Activities:

- Assist with producing the Victoria Fringe Eve Preview and FringeKids events alongside the Assistant Production Manager, under the supervision of the Producer. Includes: vendor and venue liaison, vendor booking, day-of scheduling, communicating volunteer needs to Volunteer Coordinator, artist liaison, and other producing responsibilities as required.
- Act as the on-site contact for the duration of the Fringe Eve Preview and FringeKids events.
- Assist Producer with overall festival planning, volunteer management and artist communications.
- Act as the main point of contact for audience accessibility needs, including reviewing and updating Venue Visual Guides and the Fringe Accessibility Guide, becoming familiar with all accessibility protocols for Fringe, and running daily accessibility reports for shows.
- Act as coverage for Site Office, Front of House, Box Office, and Festival Hub as needed.
- Provide on-site festival support as needed.
- Coordinate artist services such as billeting and hospitality.
- Provide coverage for Site Office and Front of House as needed.
- Provide administrative support to the Producer as needed.
- Represent the Fringe and Intrepid Theatre in a professional manner in all public facing activities.
- Attend all festival training and staff orientations.
- Support Equity, Diversity, Inclusion, and Accessibility at the Fringe.
- Other related duties as assigned.
