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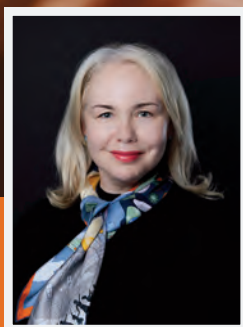

The Victoria Fringe remains committed to creating an inclusive environment for audiences, staff, volunteers, and artists.

ACCESSIBILITY GUIDE

The Fringe Accessibility Guide includes all features available at the festival, including the Fringe on the House program, priority seating, and an at-a-glance breakdown of each show.

VISUAL STORIES

Each venue at the Fringe has its own visual venue story, which includes details such as accessible washrooms, box office location, and venue parking.

Some shows at the Fringe have a visual story, offering a scene-by-scene overview, including major events, characters, and set design. It lists events such as when to expect loud noises or major visual changes. This is designed to be helpful to our audience members on the autism spectrum, or anyone who want to know what to expect before coming to a show.

ACCESSIBLE COMPANION TICKETS PROGRAM

Free tickets are available to all companions of patrons who identify as part of the d/Disability community.

Call our box office at 250-383-2663 to ask for a companion ticket when booking.

FRINGE ON THE HOUSE PROGRAM

If for any reason the cost of a ticket is beyond your means, we have a select number of tickets for every show available for free, no questions asked. Just call our box office at 250-383-2663 and ask for a **Fringe on the House** ticket (limited to one ticket per person, per show, and up to a maximum of 5 shows).

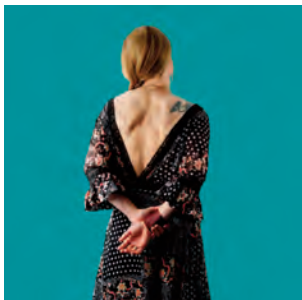

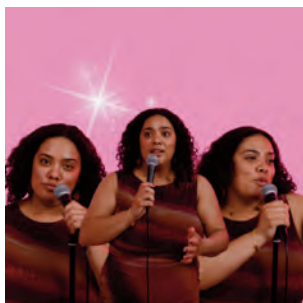

Fringe Buttons can be purchased online or in person, and must be shown at the door to your show with your ticket.

WHERE can I buy one? And WHEN?

1. online, any time: under "Merchandise", or when prompted at the bottom of your basket. Pick it up in advance at the Intrepid Box Office, or at the door of the venue at your first show.
2. Intrepid Box Office during open hours.
3. at the venue 15 minutes before your show begins.

WHY do I need one?

Because 100% of the net ticket price (that's your ticket cost without any fees) is returned directly to the artists you choose to see!

We don't keep the cost of the ticket; the money Intrepid raises from sales of the Fringe Button is what allows us to produce the Fringe.

We thank you for your support in helping us bring the Fringe to life year after year.
